



## VOCABULAIRE

The words in the vocabulary list are given in the same form (or one of the same forms) that they appear in in the text of *Pauvre Anne*.

Unless a subject of a verb in the vocabulary list is expressly mentioned, the subject is third-person singular. For example, *accompagne* is given as only *goes with*. In complete form this would be *she, he or it goes with*.
